



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Central Texas Coalition Against Human Trafficking  
Created May 1, 2009

### **I. PURPOSE**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between members of the Central Texas Coalition Against Human Trafficking (CTCAHT) is to:

- (1) Ensure a clear understanding of the mission and work of the CTCAHT and the role of the CTCAHT member(s).
- (2) Build and/or enhance collaborative efforts between CTCAHT members in order to strengthen (and not duplicate) CTCAHT work and services to victims of human trafficking.

### **II. MISSION AND WORK**

The mission of the CTCAHT is to “work collaboratively to increase public awareness and identification of human trafficking cases, and to provide identified victims of human trafficking with comprehensive social and medical services.” The CTCAHT works towards its mission by:

- 1) Creating and presenting professional trainings on human trafficking.
- 2) Creating and disseminating outreach to at-risk populations and to raise community awareness.
- 3) Focusing on providing and enhancing social services to victims of trafficking.

### **III. MEMBER ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

Members of the CTCAHT will serve on one committee each year. Members are responsible for attending committee and CTCAHT meetings and disseminating pertinent information from these meetings to their respective agencies. Members are not expected (or permitted by the CTCAHT) to act in any service provision role to victims of trafficking unless this service provision role is a responsibility through their respective professional agency.

### **IV. IMPLEMENTATION**

The implementation of this agreement becomes effective upon signing. This MOU will remain in effect until action is initiated to dissolve the agreement as evidenced by written notice from an authorized representative. Any amendments to the MOU shall be in writing and executed in the same manner as the original MOU.
